Sir, presently qualifying criteria for turnover is for past four years. It is a well known fact that economic growth has slowed down and over and above COVID -19 has changed growth scenario altogether.

Secondly, the contractor's turnover very much depends on Government and its PSU's and with decline in construction sector, the contractors turnover has declined and thus total turnover for last four years took DIP, thus disqualifying working contractors, working for decades with Industrial Development Authorities.

Thirdly, decline in turnover in subsequent years does not mean that capacity and capabilities of contractors have declined as Government funding in new projects has gone down.


Fourthly, U P Jal Nigam have policy of considering works experience certificates of last ten years and also give 8% enhancement per year for the purpose of computing total turnover to qualify for the bid.

Resultantly, **BAI** members working with industrial authorities are not having works and thus earlier policy needs review to revitalize construction activity.

Under these severe conditions, I request you to kindly consider works experience certificates of last ten years for qualifying criteria of turnover instead of four years for which the construction fraternity shall remain ever grateful.
